The day care centers remain closed furthermore.

In exceptional cases, emergency care can be offered. However, this only includes 13 places in the daycare centers and 8 places in the **day nursery group**.

EMERGENCY CHILDCARE PLACES

The following families can take advantage of a full-time or part-time emergency childcare place (application at the day care center)

children of parents in systemically important professions

BOTH parents must be employed

single parent children

working single parents with sole custody, joint or shared custody, if it is not possible to organize the care of the child together

children with educational support needs

children from families with German as a second language with linguistic, curative, educational or great needs in several areas

children from families with cases of hardship

- child welfare endangerment
 - threat of job loss
- imminent significant loss of earnings (e.g. self-employed)
- particular stress factors (e.g., diseased parent)

DAYS OF EXONERATION

If there are still places available after the emergency care places have been allocated, the day-care center management can provide the remaining places as individual days of exoneration for the parents.

These days of exoneration can be available for the following cases (application in the day care center):

children of parents who both work

if neither childhood sick days nor loss of earnings payments can be used

children of parents in the home office

if the home office has to work at a fixed time and not staggered and if additional requirements have to be met (e.g. homeschooling)
